### Entry Procedures

1. Entry fee for S.A.S.A. Graded classes R375 (including levies).
2. Entry fee for S.A.S.A. Newcomers & S.A. Riding Horse classes R350 (including levies)
3. Entry Fee for General Breed Classes R350
4. Entry Fee for Young Children's and All Breed Classes R325. Groom's classes R100
5. Levies for Graded S.A.S.A. classes include SASA levy R50 and R6.00 EDTS levy.
6. Levies for SASA S.A. Riding Horse classes, Newcomers and General Breed SASA Levy R33 and R6.00 EDTS levy
7. Levy for other classes R10
8. Prizemoney of 40% of entry fees less levies will be paid for Graded S.A.S.A. classes.
9. Prizes for SASA S.A. Riding Horse classes, Newcomers, All Breeds, General Breed & Young Children's classes Rosettes + any sponsorship.
10. Levies for all classes include R75 ground levy, R50 officials levy and R50 medic levy.
11. All entries must have reached the Show Organiser by closing date.
12. All payments must be made by EFT (or cash by prior arrangement with the organizers)
- 13. ENTRY FORMS: Entries for all classes listed in this schedule must be done via the S.A.S.A. website [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za)**
14. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS (Education, Development, & Transformation Scheme) competitors in all classes. Up to 4 **Ridden classes** per day. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za) or from [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za). Registered EDTS members will receive National EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
15. Registered SASA Instructors will receive National Instructor Victor Ludorum points for pupils that compete in the SASA classes.

### 2. MEMBERSHIP AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

**The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.**

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. For Membership see the SASA website [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za) or from [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za).
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in a maximum of 4 Ridden classes per day. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za) or contact [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za) for more information. EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 26 effective 1st January 2026
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za)
13. Newcomers are open to riders who have never competed in graded classes in any age group. No cross entry with Graded Classes.
14. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
15. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.
16. All required vaccines and primaries must reflect in passports and be in accordance with SAEF directives

### 3. REFUNDS

1. Full refunds will be given if the entry is not accepted by the Committee due to classes being over/under subscribed, or if the classes are cancelled prior to the start of the show.
2. If any section of this show is cancelled due to bad weather, there will be a refund of entry fees minus 10% admin. Charge.

### 4. TIMETABLE

A provisional timetable appears at the end of the schedule as a guide. This may change depending on the number of entries. Competitors are advised to check with Contact persons for any changes. The show committee reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes.

### 5. VARIATION TO PROGRAMME

The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to the programme. Every effort will be made to inform all those affected individually, but notice of the exercising of the above mentioned will be deemed to have been given to all concerned by: -

- a) A NOTICE BEING PLACED ON THE EQUESTRIAN NOTICE BOARDS AT THE MAIN ARENA AND SHOW OFFICE.
- b) MENTION OVER THE EQUESTRIAN PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM.

Competitors are requested to be correctly dressed, according to the S.A.S.A. rules, when in any of the arenas. T-Shirts are not allowed.

### 8. OBJECTIONS AND APPEALS

SASA rules apply.

### 9. EXERCISING OF HORSES

NO exercising of horses is allowed in the arenas.

### 10. CLASHING OF CLASSES

Whilst every effort will be made to avoid clashes of classes, competitors who make multiple entries do so at their own discretion, as classes cannot be delayed. You are advised to check the provisional timetable thoroughly before entering.

  4. In-Hand Utility Class  
Open to all Competitors. Additional prizes to the highest placed grooms in this class. Competitors to lead their horses/ponies over a course of 6 obstacles.
  - 5 **Cob Ridden class**  
*Open to horses/ponies of all Breeds which meet the description below. To encourage entries, horses may be plaited or have hogged manes.*  
The Cob is a type rather than a breed. A short-legged animal, with bone, substance and quality, capable of carrying a substantial weight. The Cob should be well mannered and ideal for nervous or elderly riders. Cobs should have sensible heads, (sometimes roman nosed), a full generous eye, shapely neck, well muscled, with a hogged mane (showing no significant growth) and well defined wither. The Cob should also have clean, strong hocks and all the attributes of a good hunter; low movement and a comfortable ride. *(Winner to go forward to Supreme Class 5002)*
  - 6 **" New" Horse/pony Ridden class**  
Open to horses or ponies which have never competed in SASA graded classes.  
*( no cross entry with SASA graded classes)*
