3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions

are available at [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za) or from [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za). EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.

4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.

5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.

6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 26 effective 1 Jan 2026

7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA,

OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.

8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.

9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge

10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.

11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.

12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their

	<p>principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website <a href="http://www.showingsa.co.za">www.showingsa.co.za</a></p> <p>13. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.</p> <p>14. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.</p> <p>15. On no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse take part in any of the showing classes if the horse has been ridden by anyone other than the competitor or judge from the first day of the show until the end of the last class in which that horse competes.</p>
<b>PASSPORTS</b>	Please bring up to date passports that include a valid height certificate, to the show grounds. These may be checked before entry to the event / venue / competition is permitted.
<b>HORSE FLU AND AHS</b>	The Show Director reserves the right to refuse entries of ponies/horses not up to date with FLU vaccinations
<b>SUBSTITUTIONS</b>	A Substitution of rider or pony / horse will be permitted provided the correct forms are completed and signed by all relevant parties and submitted to the Show Secretary no less than one hour before the commencement of the class(es).
<b>DOGS</b>	Well behaved DOGS ON A LEAD are allowed
