GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This is a SAEF sanctioned event and will be run under SAEF General Regulations and the current discipline rules. SASA, DSA, SASJ, ESA, and the Ranch Equestrian Centre relevant rules and regulations apply. The SAEF, SASA, DSA, SAEQA, and SASJ levies have been included in the entry fee and are detailed in the schedule.
2. Results for graded classes will count for grading points, subject to the approval of the relevant SAEF Official.
3. All riders are to wear protective headgear on the show grounds when mounted. Children and Juniors are to wear the correct restraining harness on their hat as stated in rule 12.2.2.
4. SAEF, SASA, DSA, ESA, SASJ, and Show Organizers will not accept responsibility for any loss of property, damage, or injury sustained by owners, competitors, and members of the public or any other person or their property at the Ranch Equestrian Centre for the duration of the Show.
5. Dogs are welcome at shows; they must be under control and on leads at all times. A fine of R500 WILL be imposed on the owners if dogs are found loose.
6. No late entries or entries without proof of payment will be accepted. Entries without valid FLU and AHS details will not be accepted.
7. It is the competitor's responsibility to check whether their entries have been received.
8. The Organising Committee/Show Holding Body reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes should this be necessary. Always provided such amendments are not in conflict with the National Rules.
9. Junior and Adult classes may be combined if entries are insufficient to hold the classes individually. In showing and dressage classes, separate prizes will be awarded for Juniors and Adults.
10. The program appearing in this schedule is STRICTLY PROVISIONAL and may change once all entries are received. Competitors are urged not to enter classes based purely on provisional program times.
11. Prize money awarded will only be for GRADED classes.
12. So far as possible, the programme, and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to. However, the Organising Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavourable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances.
13. **No refund will be given after the closing date of entries if a competitor scratches for whatever reason. If you have entered this show and scratch your entry after the closing date, you will still be liable to pay your fees.**
14. By entering a stallion at the Ranch Equestrian Centre, the competitor and owner agree to the following conditions and agree to abide by the following protocols:
 - a. Competition stallions always remain the responsibility of the owner and rider, and they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury, or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - b. It is the responsibility of the owner and rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - c. The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise and preparation/competition, and only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
 - d. Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the Ranch Equestrian Centre premises.
 - e. All stallions must always wear a yellow tag on their bridles and tails.

RULES

The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. For Membership see the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za.
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTs competitors in a maximum of 4 Ridden classes per day. The competitor must be an EDTs member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTs application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or contact admin@showingsa.co.za for more information. EDTs competitors will earn EDTs Victor Ludorum points.
4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 26 effective 1st January 2026
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za
13. Newcomers are open to riders who have never competed in graded classes in any age group. **No cross entry with**

Graded Classes.

14. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
15. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.
16. All required vaccines and primaries must reflect in passports and be in accordance
